- A servant is coming.

<u>1. Who is sending this servant?</u>

Isaiah 42:5

• God, the Lord who created the heavens and earth, who gives breath, who gives spirit to people - this Almighty God is sending this special Servant.

2. Who is this servant?

Isaiah 42: 1

• Behold my servant, someone chosen by God

Mathew 3:17

- This is my beloved son whom I am well pleased, in whom my soul delights.
- Elected by God, anointed by God, Gods spirit is upon Him

Mathew 12: 18-21

• Behold my Servant whom I am chosen

Acts 3: 26

• God raised up this Servant to bless you

Isaiah 52:13

• Behold my Servant He will be exalted and lifted up

Philippians 2: 6-11

• Taking the form of a Servant

Mathew 12: 15-17

• A servant doesn't want any reputation

Isaiah 53: 11

• A righteous Servant who justify many.
